A new Ohio Administrative code for your Fundraising Contract came out in a letter from the Ohio Attorney General the first of October. The new code states you must have a signed contract for each 501c3 organization you donate gaming funds to and also the 501c3 organization must have its primary place of business in Ohio. This means Ohio lodges cannot donate gaming funds directly to Moose Charities but you can **DONATE GAMING FUNDS TO THE OHIO STATE MOOSE ASSOCIATION MUSEUM INC. AND THE MUSEUM WILL DONATE THE MONEY ON YOUR BEHALF TO MOOSE CHARITIES.** The check must be made out to OSMA Museum Inc. and sent to:

You **MUST** designate where you want the funds to go i.e.; Museum general fund, Moose Charities, Mooseheart, Moosehaven Centennial Project, etc. Please don't forget the Ohio Moose still has a \$1,000,000.00 Ohio Project to help fund the new congregate living facility at Moosehaven.

The new Fundraising contract for the OSMA Museum Inc. is posted on the OSMA Website. Follow the directions below to find this letter and the Fundraising Contract.

If you go to the Ohio State Moose Association website, (ohiomoose.com), near the top of the home page, and on the right side in gray bar, click on the word "museum", and it will direct you to the OSMA Museum, Inc. portal. On this portal, you can click on a link to take a virtual tour of the museum. Also, there is an area with instructions on how to make donations, such as how the check is to be made out, and where to send the check. There is also a place where you can click, and print off a downloadable Ohio Attorney General Fraternal Gaming Contract. The 2016 Ohio Attorney General Fraternal Gaming contract will be available on the Ohio Attorney Generals website after November 1, 2016 and on the OSMA website shortly after November 1, 2015.

In conclusion, all donations to the museum will be greatly appreciated. We are very proud of our Museum, and we are one of the few Associations within the Moose Fraternity that has their own museum.
