1. We have recently built a "Wind Break" room outside of the door in the Social Quarters that leads outside and to the "Smokers Cabin." This small room is not an area which is to be used by Smokers. If you are going out to smoke, you must either go all the way outside, or go into the "Smokers Cabin." When going into the "Smokers Cabin," it will be necessary for you to close (slide) the Cabin Door into a closed position. This will eliminate or at least minimize the possibility of smoke coming into the Social Quarters. The "Wind Break" was built at the request of Members who were becoming chilled, due to the cold air rushing in when that exterior door was opened. It will also help the Lodge financially, by limiting heat loss and heat bills.
