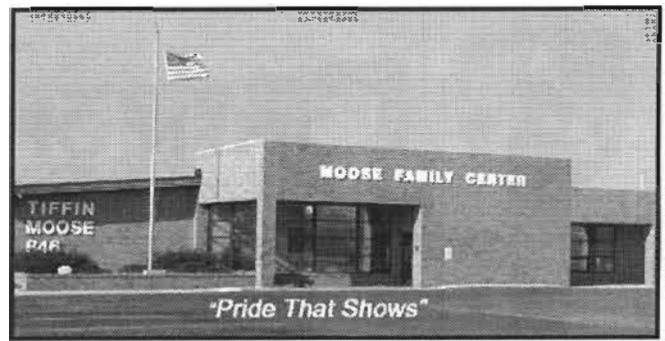

Soup-r-Bowl Sunday

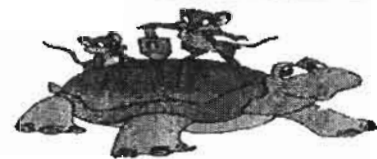
