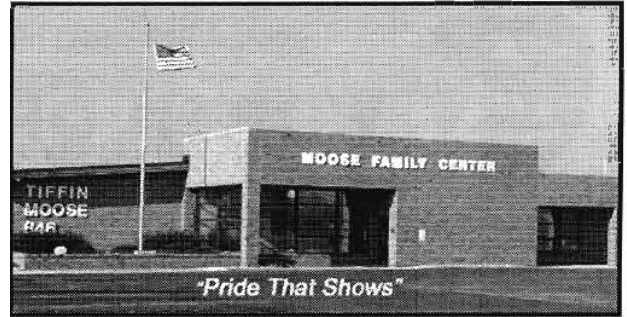

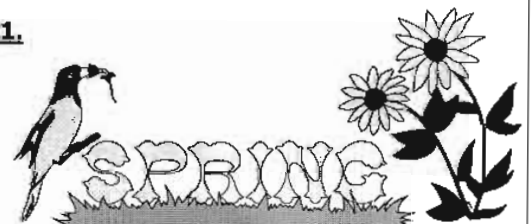

Golfers and Softball Players

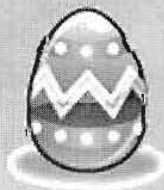
