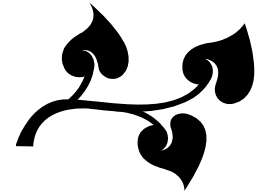

**AJ Feiock to represent Belmont County at
the Scripps National Spelling Bee in D.C**

Perhaps it isn't too surprising that the favorite word to spell for the 2010 Belmont County Spelling Champion AJ Feiock is "supercalifragilisticexpialidocious" as it sometimes represents the longest word in the English language. As a Union Local Middle School eighth grader, Feiock studied many words in order to gain the county championship, thus enabling him to represent Belmont County in the 2010 Scripps National Spelling Bee this week in Washington, D.C. Sheryl Sonk, his teacher/coach, said the 13-year-old student, whose parents are Brent and Kris Feiock, practiced words with his teenage sister, Cassie, prior to the county bee, sponsored by The Times Leader and Riesbeck's Food Markets. "He is very excited about this," said Sonk. Feiock will be among 273 spellers competing for the national title, and this involves the largest number of U.S.-based spellers in the history of the event. Even though his favorite word is the one so familiar to "Mary Poppins" fans, the national spelling bee Web site reveals that the favorite words among all the spellers are schadenfreude, pfeffernuss and onomatopoeia. This marks the second year that the Union Local student has been in the county bee. Despite his ability in spelling, Feiock's favorite school subject is mathematics. As to his vocation in the future, he is interested in becoming an architect or a game designer or would like to work in the electronics field. Feiock as first-place winner in Belmont County earned an all-expenses-paid trip, including deluxe accommodations for himself, a parent and a coach during the week of the national competition. In addition to the first-place title and trophy, he received a \$1,000 U.S. Savings Bond, Webster's Third New International Dictionary (unabridged), the Samuel Louis Sugarman Award \$100 Series EE U.S. Savings Bond, a plaque featuring the two winning words for school display, a traveling trophy for school display (provided by Belmont County Spelling Bee sponsors, The Times Leader and Riesbeck's Food Markets) and a one-year subscription to the Britannica Kids Online Student Edition an Amazon.com gift certificate. (AJ is the son of Moose Member Brent Feiock)
