Festivities begin at 1:30 p.m. and will continue until 9:00 p.m. *Come join us for a super great time, delicious food, and some fine entertainment.*

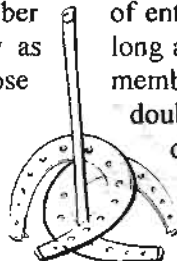
