## OHIO STATE MOOSE SWEETHEART BOWLING ASSOCIATION TORUNAMENT RULES

1. All entrants must show a current WOTM Membershio card and USBC card purchased in Ohio at the time of checking in. Teams are to be checked in by Captains or Representatives at least one hour prior to their scheduled event. Any substitutions are to be made at this time.
2. Entrants must use their highest USBC sanctioned average of the 2008-2009 season; unless their final average of the 2009-2010 season ins ten (10) pins higher. If a bowler does not qualify in either case, she must bowl scratch.
3. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if the average submitted is lower than the correct average. Corrections in the averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series. We are using the 10-pin-over average; not the 15; and we do not wish to change that rule at this time. Rule 319E will be waived for this tournament. Included in this rule will be the statement “or base-prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher”. The 10-pins-over average rule is for 21 games or more for the 2008-2009 bowling season.
4. Entrants may participate twice in each event, provided the entries are covered by fees and scheduled accordingly. However, an entrant may only collect winnings once in her singles and doubles events. In case of multiple team entries, there must be a difference of at least two bowlers in order to collect winnings in both teams.
5. Subs may bowl as many times as needed but will only collect prize money in her actual paid-up schedule events.
6. A bowler arriving late may be permitted to bowl, beginning in the frame that is being rolled at the time she is ready. There will be no score allowed for the missed frames. A tardy bowler may not replace a pacer or sub until the following game. In cases of emergency or injury after a game has begun, the game will be paced-out with an amount determined from the frames bowled. A sub or pacer may be made in the following game, with the handicap being made from that bowler’s average.
7. Bowlers are not permitted to “Open Bowl” on the tournament lanes of the tournament dates that they are scheduled.
8. The Official Corer shall be designated as the “Hosting Chairman”. No score may be changed once they have been brought to the attention of one of the tournament officials.
9. There will be NO FLASH PICTURE TAKING while ANY bowling is in progress.
10. DRESS CODE: Bowlers may not wear revealing clothing that may tend to distract or disrupt others’ while bowling. Clothing that may reveal the anatomy of the body, when bowling, will not be permitted.
11. **Entries will close April 15, 2010.**
12. All prize fees collected in each event will be returned 100%. After the prize fund has been compiled, the prize list will be posted during the length of the tournament. The prize ration to be established based on entries.
13. Any protest or appeal shall be made in writing and submitted to the OSMSBA Board no later than 48 hours after the games have been bowled.
14. One-tenth of each entry will be targeted to Mooseheart for their project of that year. This will be designated as a donation from the OSMSBA tournament bowlers. This donation will be deducted from the account of tournament expenses.
15. No bowlers will be permitted to operate the auto-scorekeepers – per disqualification.
16. USBC tournament rule 319-D of reporting prior prize winning, will apply to this tournament. All prizes of \$300 or more, in money or merchandise, in the last (12) months, must be reported as a condition of entry.
