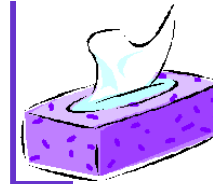

Midyear School Supplies



1. Donating Supplies

You may bring actual school supplies to the Midyear Conference in February of 2019. Collection containers will be available in both the LOOM & WOTM meeting areas.

Items you may donate include:

disinfectant wipes; file folders;
tissues; folders; hand sanitizer;
storage containers; thin & thick markers; index cards; glue; crayons; eraser caps; backpacks; pencils; pens; notebook paper; binders; notebooks; glue sticks; highlighters; flash drives; calculators; art supplies; sheet protectors; printer paper; colored pencils; carriers; etc.



2. Lodge or Chapter Check

A lodge or chapter check made out to Moose Charities may be donated in lieu of the community service project described. These checks will be forwarded to Moose International and applied to a fund drive of your lodge's or chapter's choice by noting that choice in the memo section of the check. If nothing is noted, they will become a part of the endowment fund.



3. Cash Donations

Offerings of cash will be used to purchase reasonable supplies so that they may be delivered to the school districts chosen by the winning lodge or chapter.

4. Noisy Money Donations

Offerings of American monetary coins will be accepted and counted for reporting to those in attendance at the closing session of the conference. These monies will be used in the same manner as the cash donations.



Which school districts will benefit?

A typical Moose style drawing will be made at a conference meeting with all lodges/chapters included in the drawing. The winning lodge or chapter must be represented at the meeting of the drawing. If the first name drawn is not present, another will be drawn until a winner is found. The winners will have the option of choosing the school district(s) to benefit from their win. A Moose representative will deliver the supplies to the district chosen with the winning lodge/chapter's presence for a photo op.
